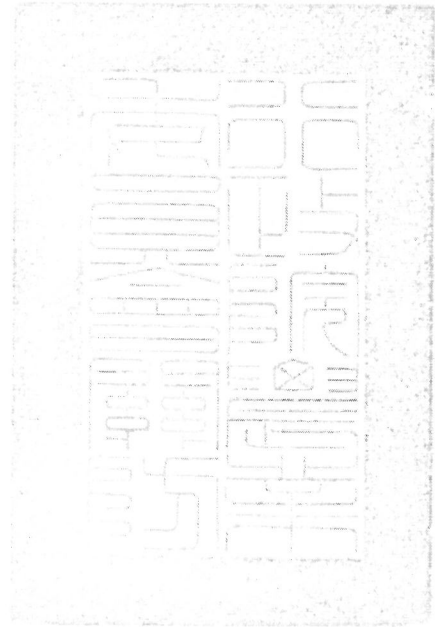

主旨：訂定「十足目虹彩病毒之指定輸入應施檢疫物及檢疫措施」，
並自中華民國一百零九年五月二十九日生效。

依據：動物傳染病防治條例第三十三條第四項。

公告事項：附訂定「十足目虹彩病毒之指定輸入應施檢疫物及檢疫
措施」1份。

十足目虹彩病毒之指定輸入應施檢疫物及檢疫 措施

- 一、本措施依動物傳染病防治條例第三十三條第四項規定訂定之。
- 二、指定之檢疫疾病為十足目虹彩病毒 (Decapod iridescent virus 1, DIV1)。
- 三、指定之應施檢疫物如下：
 - (一)克氏原螯蛄(*Procambarus clarkii*，俗稱美國螯蝦、克氏螯蝦、小龍蝦)。
 - (二)四脊滑螯蝦(*Cherax quadricarinatus*，俗稱澳洲淡水龍蝦)。
 - (三)日本沼蝦(*Macrobrachium nipponense*)。
 - (四)泰國長臂大蝦(*Macrobrachium rosenbergii*，俗稱泰國蝦)。
 - (五)白蝦(*Penaeus vannamei*)。
- 四、輸入指定應施檢疫物之指定檢疫措施如下：
 - (一)前點所列之指定應施檢疫物，未列於動物及動物產品輸入檢疫條件第五點附件二之二「活甲殼類及軟體動物之輸入檢疫條件」(以下簡稱活甲殼類檢疫條件)附表一者，於本檢疫措施未規定事項，準用活甲殼類檢疫條件之規定。
 - (二)指定應施檢疫物輸出前十四日內，應經採樣檢測指定之檢疫疾病病原體結果為陰性，或輸出前來源水域或養殖場連續二年以上未發生十足目虹彩病毒。
 - (三)指定應施檢疫物輸入時所檢附之動物檢疫證明書正本，應以英文或中文加註檢測十足目虹彩病毒之採樣日期、採樣數量、檢測實驗室名稱、檢測方法

及結果，或加註來源水域或養殖場連續二年以上未發生十足目虹彩病毒。

- (四)指定應施檢疫物輸入達一千尾者，每一輸入案號，均應依第五點所定方式抽樣檢驗，並運往輸出入動物檢疫機關指定之場所隔離，等待檢驗結果；於運送及隔離期間，不得與其他動物混養。
- (五)指定應施檢疫物符合前四款規定，核發輸入動物檢疫證明書；未符合前四款規定之一者，逕予退運、撲殺或銷燬。

五、前點第四款之抽樣檢驗，應就每一來源水域或養殖場之輸入指定應施檢疫物，依下列規定採樣及送驗，其指定檢疫疾病病原體之檢驗結果應為陰性：

- (一)三十日齡(含)以下：單次輸入未達一百袋者，應準備一千尾以上之指定應施檢疫物一袋提供抽驗；單次輸入超過一百袋者，應準備一千尾以上之指定應施檢疫物二袋提供抽驗。
- (二)超過三十日齡：應準備於輸出前已與輸入指定應施檢疫物混養達十四日之同種成蝦三十尾，作為哨兵蝦提供送驗；未準備者，由輸出入動物檢疫機關逕行抽驗成蝦三十尾。但抽驗之成蝦重量均超過二十公克者，僅抽驗三尾。
- (三)同一輸入人前次輸入指定應施檢疫物經檢疫合格後，於到達港站日起一個月內，再次輸入(以到達港站日計算)相同來源水域或養殖場之指定應施檢疫物者，得免予依前二款規定抽驗一次。

Description of content: The quarantine requirements are established for the importation of <i>Procambarus clarkii</i> , <i>Cherax quadricarinatus</i> , <i>Macrobrachium nipponense</i> , <i>Macrobrachium rosenbergii</i> and <i>Penaeus vannamei</i> which are regulated objects for preventing the invasion of Decapod iridescent virus 1. The Bureau of Animal and Plant Health Inspection and Quarantine governed the imports of live shrimps based on Paragraph 4, Article 33 of the " <u>Statute for Prevention and Control of Infectious Animal Disease</u> ". Each consignment with a certain amount of packing bags and shrimps shall be provided for sample inspection for DIV1 since 29 May 2020.

Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Regulated Objects Related to Decapod Iridescent Virus 1

1. These requirements are formulated in accordance with Paragraph 4, Article 33 of the “Statute for Prevention and Control Infectious Animal Disease” .
2. The designated quarantine disease is the Decapod iridescent virus (DIV1).
3. The designated quarantine objects are listed as follows:
 - (1)*Procambarus clarkii*.
 - (2)*Cherax quadricarinatus*.
 - (3)*Macrobrachium nipponense*.
 - (4)*Macrobrachium rosenbergii*.
 - (5)*Penaeus vannamei* .
4. The designated quarantine requirements for importing designated quarantine objects are as follows:
 - (1)For the aforementioned designated quarantine objects that are not listed in Table 1 of the "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Live Crustaceans and Molluscs" of Annex 2-2 of Article 5 of the “Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Animal and Animal Products” and for matters not specified by these requirements, the quarantine requirements for live crustaceans shall be used.
 - (2)Within 14 days prior to exportation, samples shall be collected from the water area or aquaculture facility of origin for testing of the DIV1 and the results must be negative; or the DIV1 has not occurred in the exporting water area or aquaculture facility of origin for the two previous years at a minimum.

- (3) On the original animal health certificate that accompanies the designated quarantine objects to be imported, it must be issued in English or Chinese specifying the test results for DIV1 including the sampling date, number of samples, testing laboratory name, testing method and results of the testing; or the certificate must state that the DIV1 has not occurred in the exporting water area or aquaculture facility of origin for the two previous years at a minimum.
 - (4) For each import case where the number of designated quarantine import objects is 1,000 shrimps or more, sampling and testing according to the methods specified in Article 5 must be conducted at the border; the objects must then be transported to the place designated by the animal quarantine authority for quarantine to wait for the test results. During the transport and quarantine period, the quarantine objects must not be mixed with other animals.
 - (5) For designated quarantine objects that comply with all 4 preceding paragraphs of this Article, an import animal quarantine certificate will be issued; objects which do not comply with any one of the 4 preceding paragraphs of this Article will be returned, culled or destroyed.
5. The sampling and testing of the Paragraph 4 of Article 4 shall specify the designated import quarantine objects of each water area or aquaculture facility and the test result shall be negative; the sampling method is as follows:
 - (1) For objects with age of 30 days or under (counting from the hatching day):

For each water area or aquaculture facility of origin, if the importation is less than 100 bags (each batch), designated quarantine objects of more than 1,000 shrimps in one bag shall be provided for sample test. For importation of more than 100 bags (each batch), 2 bags of the designated quarantine objects in each bag with over 1,000 shrimps shall be provided for sample test.

- (2) For designated quarantine objects with age over 30 days: At least 30 shrimps of same species adult shrimps that have been mixed with the importing designated quarantine objects for 14 days shall be provided as sentinel shrimps; if no sentinel shrimps are prepared, the animal quarantine authority will randomly take at least 30 shrimps for test. If the weight of the sampled shrimp is over 20g, only three shrimps will be used.
- (3) For the same importer, after the previous importation of the designated quarantine objects have passed the quarantine inspection, to import the designated quarantine objects again from the same water area or aquaculture facility of origin, the random sampling according to the aforementioned two Paragraphs of this Article could be exempted one time if the period between the last importation and immediate importation is within 1 month.
