

**The Government's Policy on Mainland Students Studying in Taiwan Remains Unchanged;
Learning should be the Purpose of Mainland Students Studying in Taiwan**

Regarding media reports that former mainland Chinese people studying in Taiwan were suspected of involvement in developing communist spy organizations, the Mainland Affairs Council (MAC) stated that this case is under judicial proceedings.
